#### Why should you read this notice?

You have the right to understand how your information is being used. We will make sure you get all the information you need to do so.



#### Who are we?

Each company within the Saint-Gobain Group that enters into a contractual relationship with its clients, suppliers, or partners.



#### Why do we process your data?

We collect and process your data to comply with applicable legal and regulatory obligations and to carry out various checks (prior to entering into a contractual relationship and during the relationship, where applicable), for the following purposes:


- Anti-money laundering, proceeds of crime and terrorist financing checks,
- Government sanctions list checks,
- Politically exposed persons (PEP) checks,
- Adverse media checks,
- External and internal audit and control,
- Reporting and statistics,
- Management of requests to exercise rights where applicable.





#### On what grounds do we process your data?

We collect and process your data on the following basis:

- Legitimate interest in complying with our legal obligations, in particular economic sanctions and restrictive measures legislation where applicable (clients, suppliers, partners).
