





Habitat for Humanity ran a refurbishment project for ten apartments with the help of volunteers including Saint-Gobain employees and the beneficiaries of this social housing.



SAINT-GOBAIN FOUNDATION: HOW DOES IT WORK?

WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA FOR A PROJECT TO BE ACCEPTED?

To be accepted, a project must comply with the following criteria: it must be located in a country where Saint-Gobain is present; the sponsor must be a Saint-Gobain employee or retiree near the project; the project must fit with one of the Foundation's two focus areas (social housing or youth professional integration); and it must be run by a non-profit organization and benefit people experiencing some form of hardship.

HOW DO I SUBMIT A PROJECT?

As a sponsor, you **submit a project online** at http://fondation.saint-gobain-initiatives.com/ and undertake to personally to follow the project all the way to its completion.

HOW ARE PROJECTS SELECTED?

The Foundation team checks that the acceptance criteria are met and asks the sponsor to fill out the application, which is then submitted to the **Selection Committee**. This Committee issues an initial opinion and forwards the shortlisted projects to the **Management Committee**, which makes the final decision and allocates the funding.

STAKEHOLDERS

A tripartite agreement is signed by the sponsor, the association and the Foundation. The sponsor follows the project from beginning to end and participates in its assessment upon its completion in liaison with the Foundation team.
